Michael discussed the Sarasota Planning Organization Board meeting they had last week, noting that Sasaki presented great concepts. He added that in April, Sasaki will be sharing the three design concept options and with feedback from the community sessions in February. He reminded the committee that the concepts remain true to the guiding principles.

In April there will be more open house sessions with Sasaki and another Herald-Tribune forum.

Klauber introduced Sue Stewart, the Mission Manager of the SBPO. Sue provided details of the April sessions and information from AtLarge for Stakeholders to help spread the word to their constituents.

Stakeholders asked that at the next meeting, time be allocated for the group to share each organization's input on the design concepts.
