Michael Klauber opened the meeting and attendees introduced themselves. Mr. Klauber asked the guests if they would like to speak. There being no comments, Mr. Klauber continued with an update on the February 17 unanimous vote by the Sarasota City Commission in support of the vision and implementation principles. He congratulated all Stakeholders.

Klauber informed the Stakeholders that the City Commission has directed City Staff to move forward with forming a Technical Advisory Panel that can begin its work while the cultural facility assessments are going on.

Klauber then asked for feedback from the Stakeholders on issues that need to be covered or reviewed by the Technical Panel.

Sarasota Bayfront 20:20 is working with HR&A in exploring options for the design process that will be needed. Bayfront 20:20 is looking at case studies on funding and governance models for community-focused development efforts.

Mr. Klauber informed the Stakeholders that Bayfront 20:20 will continue its community outreach. He will be giving the CEO forum an update and will be presenting to the City of Sarasota's Parks, Recreation & Environmental Protection Advisory Board on March 19th.

Klauber updated the Stakeholders on the change of date of the April Stakeholders meeting to April 23.
